NCTCOG staff will summarize several topics:

- Recent and expected population growth.
- Recent bicycle/pedestrian planning activities.
- Long-term bicycle/pedestrian goals included in Mobility 2030—the long-term, multimodal transportation plan for the region.
- Funding priorities and goals for trail implementation.

About the Veloweb

The Regional Veloweb is a 644-mile, designated off-street trail network planned to provide bicycle and pedestrian connections in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. Currently 119 miles of the network are complete and an additional 34 miles of trail have been funded. Regional Veloweb plans are included in Mobility 2030—the long-term, multimodal transportation plan.

Discussion topics include:

- Specific opportunities to realign, connect, and expand the existing Veloweb plan.
- Prioritization of projects.

Attendees will have the opportunity to review maps and provide feedback about existing and planned bicycle/pedestrian facilities in Denton County.
