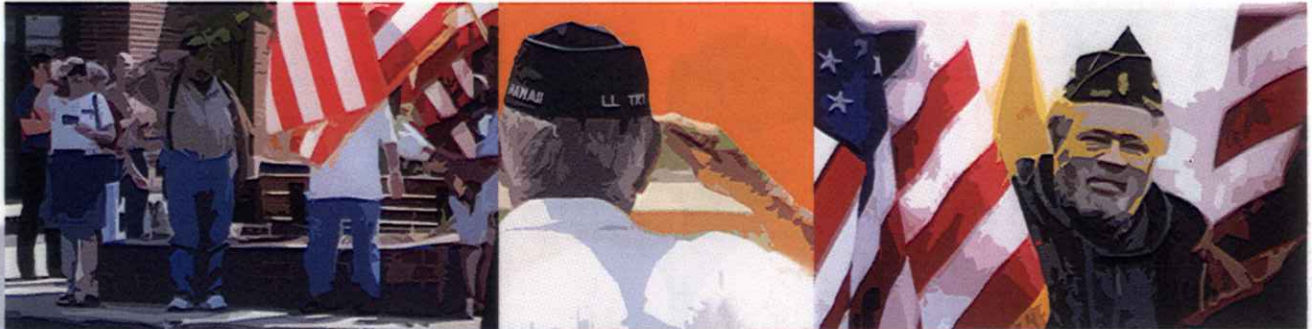

## **Mexican-American neighborhoods to honor East Austin vets with parade**

Friday, June 15, 2012

Bring your children, pets, bikes, skateboards, American flags and walking shoes and join the pre-Fourth of July parade honoring veterans from the Mexican-American neighborhoods in East Austin on Saturday, June 30.

The El Barrio Veterans Parade will feature a color guard, horses, an AFD fire truck, low-rider cars, representatives from veterans groups, the APD and more. Candy and hundreds of small flags will be distributed along the parade route.

Official entrants in the parade will assemble in the parking lots of IBC Bank and Eastside Lumber at Pleasant Valley Rd. and E. Cesar Chavez St. The procession will begin at 10:00 a.m., and all Austin patriots, young and old, are invited to join the parade along its route west on Cesar Chavez to Chicon St., then south to Fiesta Gardens at Edward Rendon Park.

After a short program at the park honoring veterans, everyone is invited to join the Cristo Rey Jamaica already in progress there. The bazaar will feature music, games, food, and booths giving health screenings and community information.

The El Barrio Veterans Parade is being organized by LULAC District 12 and El Concilio Mexican-American Neighborhoods.
